- 1. Name of the significant person including a picture
- 2. Date and place of birth and death including a map
- 3. Family information parents, siblings, growing up, schooling
- 4. What did they achieve? What were the challenges they faced? (chronological order) include any paintings, photographs, letters or other artefacts that support this
- 5. Include a map of the major or important places they travelled.
- 6. Why was this person important in helping to shape the colony? provide a detailed explanation using research evidence to support your reasons
- 7. Interesting facts

Present your biography in a booklet style to be presented and displayed in class. The information you present must be in your own words and give a well-structured and detailed response. Include a list of the sources you used using the site Citefast.com Challenge: include QR codes in your booklet that allow people to access specific or additional information about your chosen person in an interactive way.
